The Lincoln Theatre Association is proud to present the Lincoln debut of R&B soul diva **Leela James** on Thursday, April 6 at 8 pm.

The gritty-voiced contemporary soul singer has topped the Adult R&B chart multiple times for over a decade after making her assured 2006 album debut, *A Change Is Gonna Come*. Nicknamed “Baby Etta” as a little girl, James paid homage to her idol in 2012 by recording *Loving You More...In the Spirit of Etta James*. Her latest single “Reach for It” features a classic house sound and comes on the heels of her 2021 album *See Me*, which produced two #1 hits, “Complicated” and “You’re the One.” Leela has earned much acclaim from critics for her performance and songwriting skills and is currently working on her eighth studio album.

“From the legends of Etta James and James Brown to the contemporary stars of Maysa and Leela James, the lights of the Lincoln have shined on the authentic grandeur of this historical site for more than 90 years,” shared Executive Director Suzan Bradford. “Leela at the Lincoln is our effort to illuminate this Columbus treasure nationally.”

### **About Leela James**

R&B powerhouse singer/songwriter Leela James first burst onto the scene with her 2006 debut album *A Change Is Gonna Come*, introducing audiences to her soaring, sultry vocal dexterity. She quickly garnered nominations for Outstanding New Artist at the NAACP Image Awards and Best R&B/Soul or Rap New Artist of 2008 at the Soul Train Music Awards. James has gone on to record six subsequent albums including *My Soul* (2010), which reached #7 on the Billboard Hot R&B/Hip Hop Albums Chart, and *Did It for Love* (2017), featuring the song “Don’t Want You Back” which rose to #1 on the Billboard Adult R&B chart. Her latest single “Reach for It” comes on the heels of her 2021 album *See Me*, which produced two #1 hits, “Complicated” and “You’re the One,” as well as viral TikTok hit “Put It on Me” and “Break My Soul,” featuring Mumu Fresh.
